

WILDLIFE AT NIGHT: STARGAZING AT CREX MEADOWS

Join retired meteorology instructor Max Malmquist and Natural Resources Educator Kim Dauer for an evening of stargazing at Crex Meadows.

The evening will begin with a brief program at the Visitor Center about some of the nocturnal animals at Crex, and an introduction to the night sky in July. Then we will move to Riegel Overlook (at the north-west corner of the refuge) to explore the night sky. Bring a chair and please dress for the weather. Binoculars and scopes will be available to get a closer look at the stars.
